## Puerto Plata

On the north of a sun-drenched Caribbean island, a vacation paradise has been found. 125 kilometers of virgin beaches, clear and sandy, laced with palms, natural coves, lagoons and protected by coral reefs. The cool Atlantic breezes and the highest mountains in the Caribbean give the air the freshness of spring. The countryside is lush, green and alive with vibrant flowers. This sun-splashed paradise is in the

Dominican Republic, where the development of Playa Dorada and Playa Grande has begun.

Puerto Plata, a picturesque town, mountain-cradled and centered around a small natural harbor that welcomes cruise ships to its port, is the urban base for tourism on the north coast. The new Puerto Plata International Airport, capable of handling the largest planes now in service, is the front door to the entire northern coast and is accessible to both resorts. In the southern coast of the Dominican Republic, Santo Domingo, the capital and oldest city in the new world, is a graceful blend of old and new. You can roam colonial streets lined with shops or visit the Alcazar castle built for the son of Columbus in 1514. Luxury hotels, friendly people, good values, safety and investment incentives have made the Dominican Republic the fresh, new vacation destination.



## 2 Robert T. Jones Golf Courses

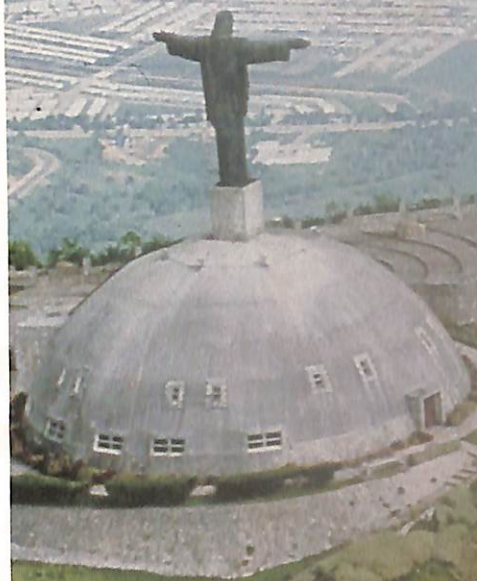
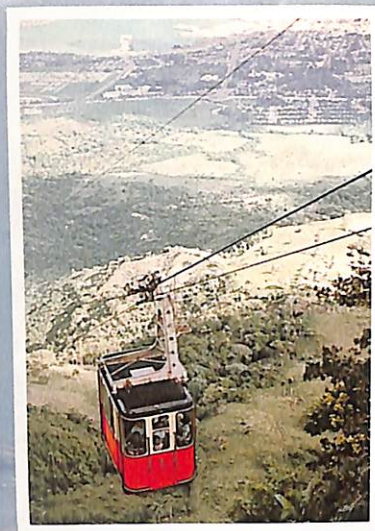
Each resort will have its own 18-hole golf course and golf club. The Playa Dorada par 72 course has been designed with yardage ranging from 5410 to 6990.

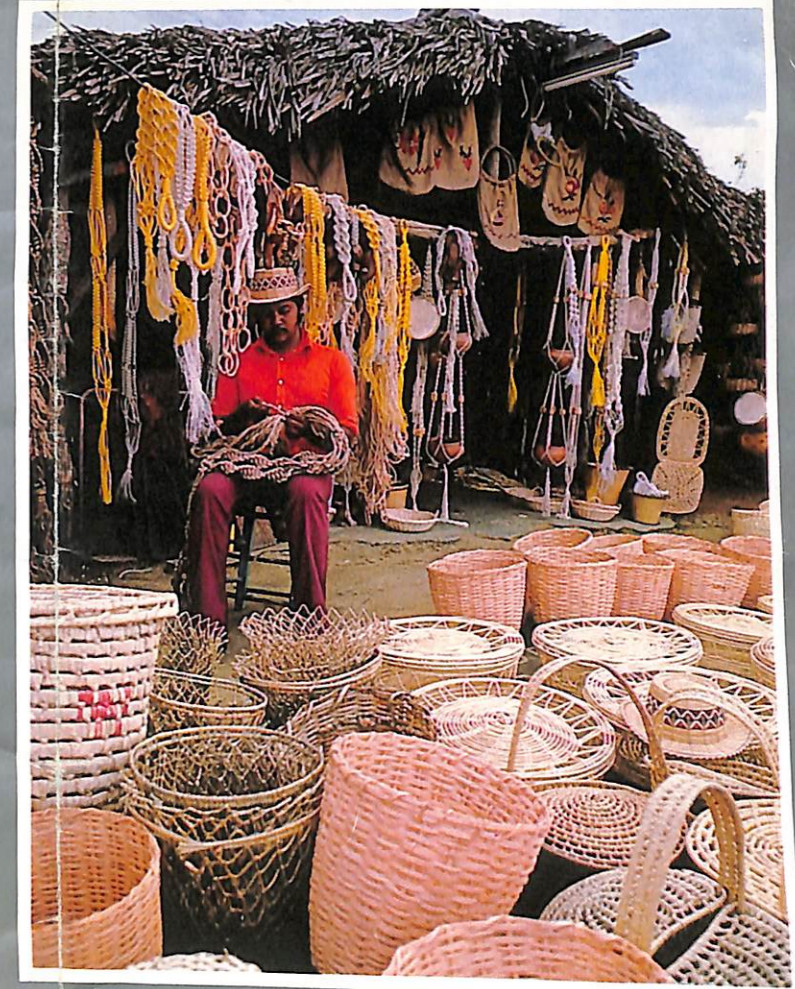
The setting for the Playa Grande par 72 course overlooks the Atlantic. 10 of the 18 holes play along the cliffs, often across small bays and coves, with yardage ranging from 5400 from the front tees to 7000 for championship play.

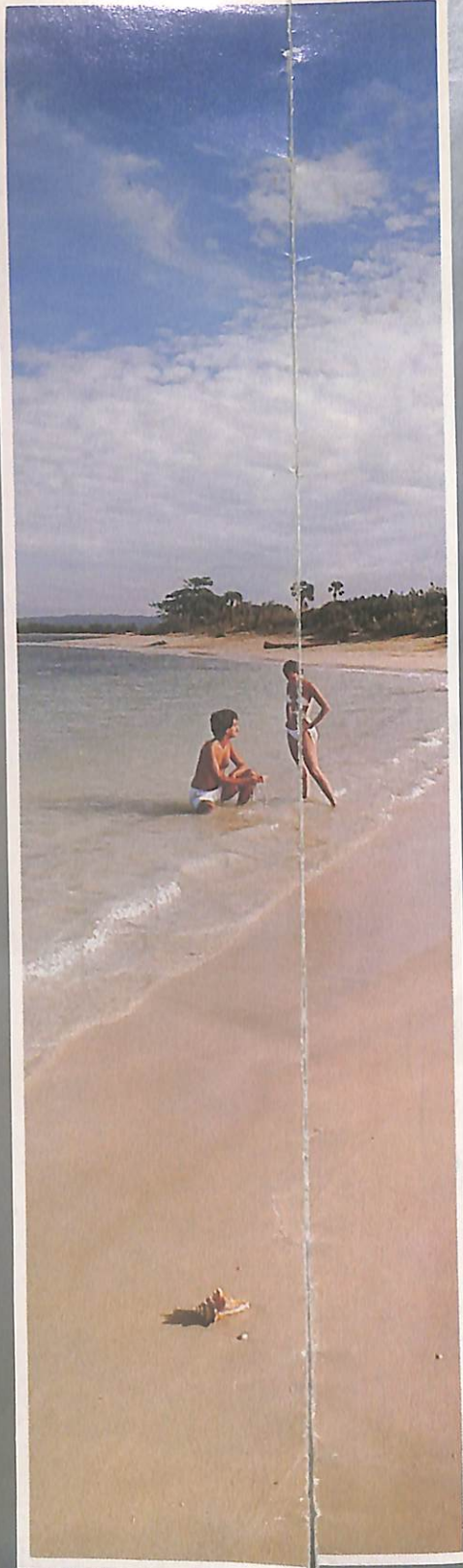
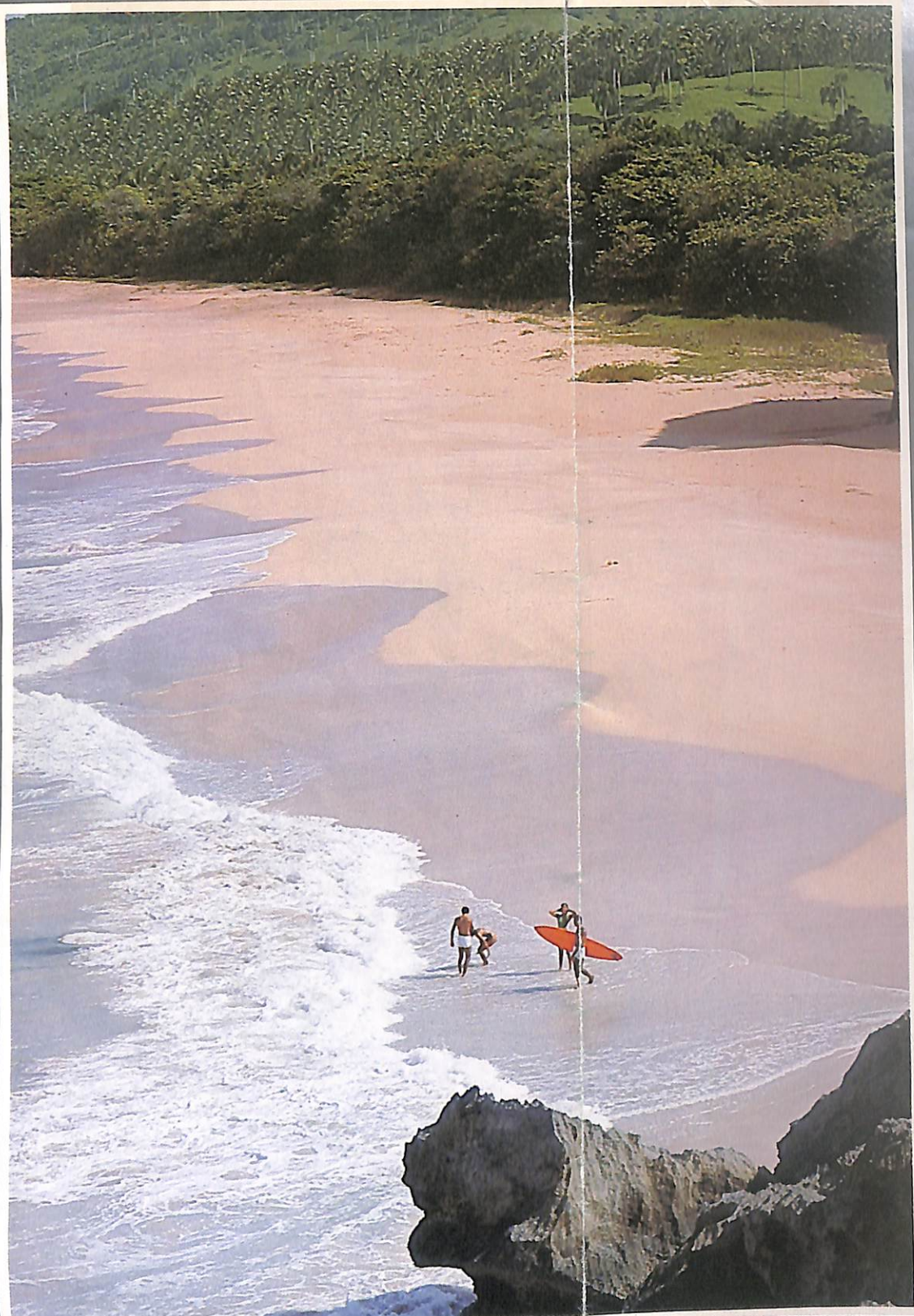
## Playa Dorada

A short distance from Puerto Plata and the airport, Playa Dorada will be the larger, more popularly priced resort complex. Off the main road, ample landscaped property juts out into the Atlantic and uncovers two crescent beaches along the coast.

Planned as a village resort complex, Playa Dorada will include two hotels, clusters of villas and apartments, a shopping plaza, convention facilities, restaurants, cinemas, beach club, riding school and stables, 20 tennis courts and several pools. The entire resort will be bounded by the spectacular oceanside 18-hole championship golf course and golf club.

Graceful pedestrian ways, pony trails, scenic routes for nontracked transit vehicles and bicycles will thread through the open spaces linking the main resort facilities and preserving the tranquil atmosphere.



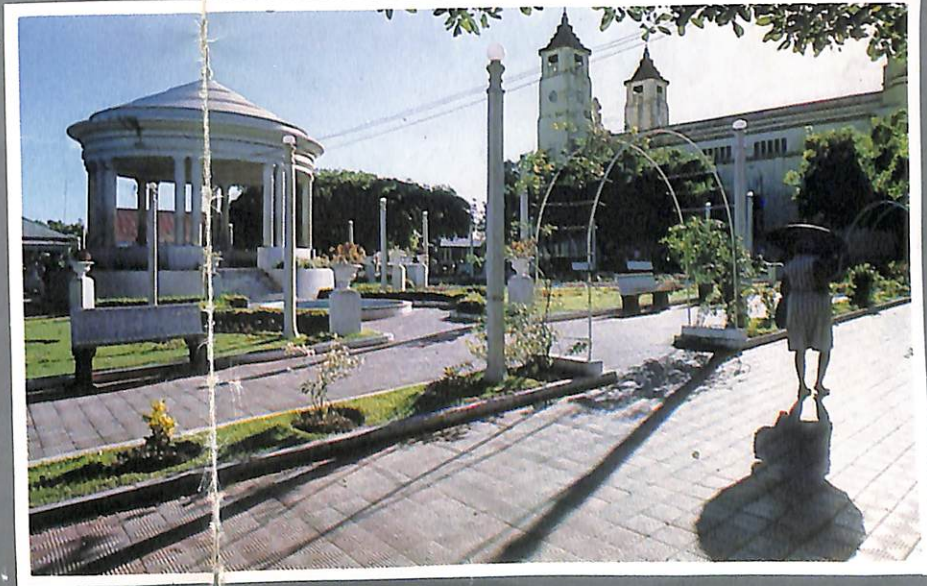
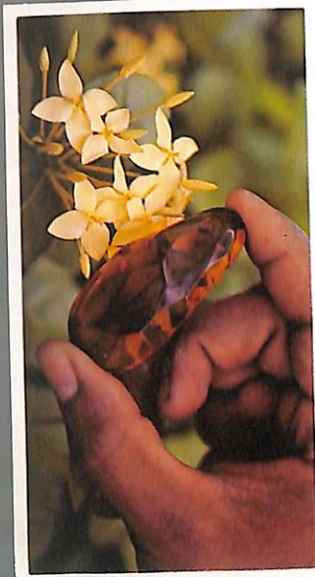
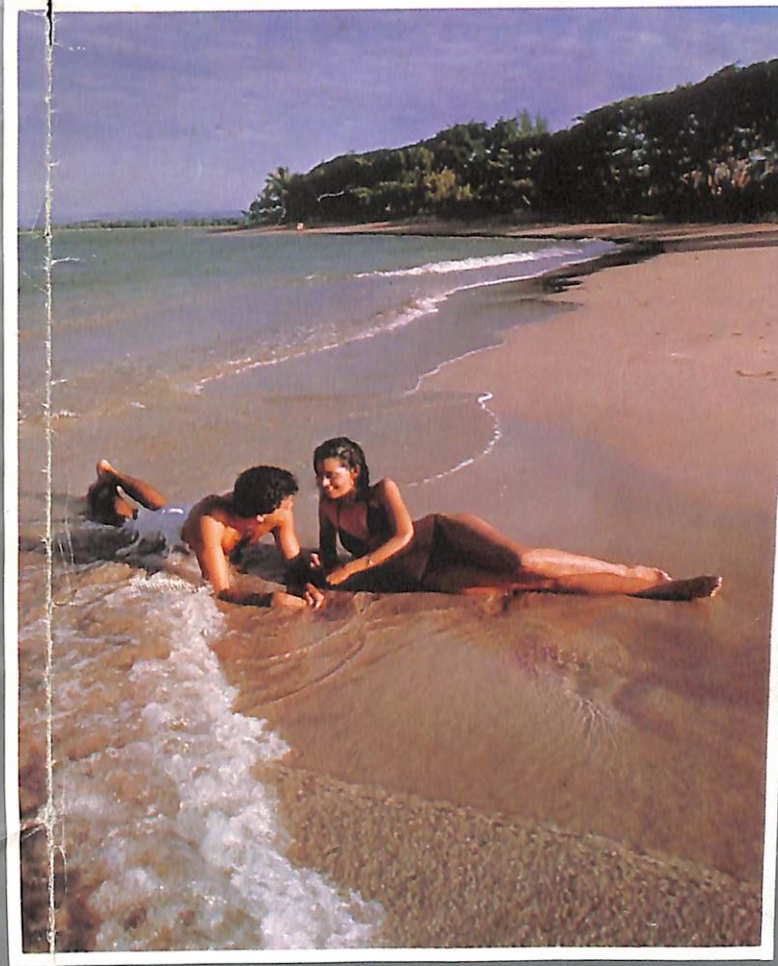


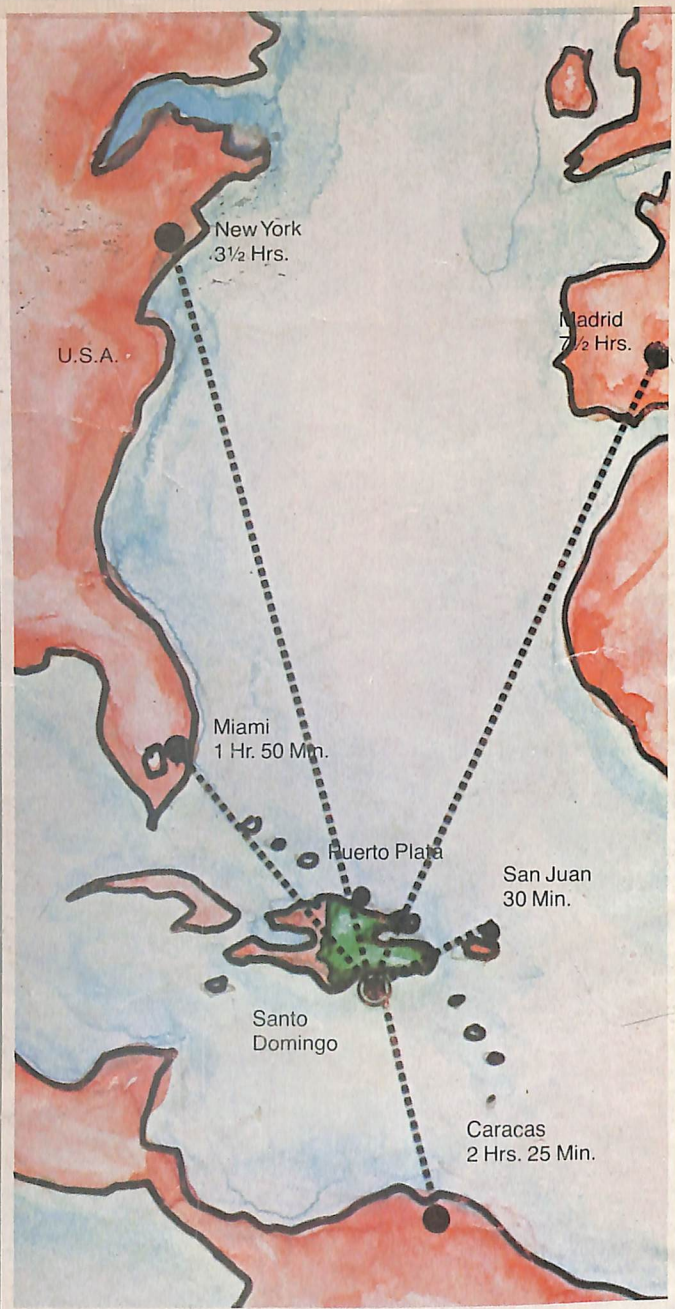
## Playa Grande

Remote, quiet luxury for the leisure tourist is the alternative offered by Playa Grande. An hour's drive from Puerto Plata International Airport, it is designed along 300 hectares of slightly sloping coconut-palm covered land, rising from a one-mile long white sandy beach. The quality of the powder-fine beach and the lush abundance of the coastline are ideally suited to the concept of a serene leisure resort.

Located on the cliffs to the west of the hotel center, is the Robert Trent Jones 18-hole championship golf course. This spectacular, oceanfront site has already been hailed as one of the most beautiful golf course settings in the world.

Luxury hotels, villas, apartments, a beach club, tennis courts and a riding school will be joined by pony trails and pedestrian footpaths; while the hotel areas will be linked to the golf course and clubhouse by way of a golf cart track, allowing guests to drive there directly.
